In 1961, the school municipalities of Isle-Maligne, Naudville, Saint Joseph d'Alma and Riverbend were amalgamated to form the school municipality of Alma. In 1962, these same municipalities will become districts of Alma while they are annexed at the municipal level. With the 1961 amalgamation, two new school municipalities were created, the Catholic School Municipality of Alma and the Protestant School Municipality of Alma. The first meeting of the School Trustees of the municipality of Alma was held on July 3rd, 1961 in Riverbend. Meetings were held there until February 1964 then in Alma until June 1970.
